Before use, all users of any Club boats, with the exception of 'Youth' Saturday sessions and Junior Week, must enter their name, boat class and club boat number together with monies paid (if applicable) in the book marked 'club boats' in the corner of the Clubhouse by the Visitor's Book. Money should be put in the adjacent red suggestion box using the envelopes provided, marked with your name, date, and boat.

All boats should be used with allocated spars, foils and sails

After use, a note of any damage caused or found on the boat or items that may need maintenance/renewal should be added in the book, and boats should be correctly tied down (see sketch below) in their allocated berth, with their covers properly in place, and the sails/foils/spars returned to their proper place - as detailed in the note below.

Charges for Club Boats
 Adults - £5.00 per day or part day - except Lasers & Supernova £10.00
 Juniors - £2.00 per day or part day - except Lasers & Supernova £5.00
 Evening charges - Adults - Lasers & Supernova £5.00, others £2.50

There is no charge for club boats being used for training, this includes formal courses, MKBYSAs meetings, 'Youth' Saturday sessions, 'Youth' Friday evening racing or by those attending Junior Week. Boats are available on a first come, first served basis except that club organised sessions always have priority.

*Please be aware that some berths, especially Picos & Toppers, may be different until the ground has been re-established after the ditch clearance. Toppers are currently on the foreshore

Club members and their families without their own dinghies are not expected to use the same class of boat for more than 6 months, at which time they should be considering a purchase of their own.

All users of Club boats will have been deemed to have read the Risk Assessment sheet displayed in the Clubhouse and in the container

Kayaks only for use during Youth sessions and Junior Week by 'coaches'

Location of equipment for 'hire' club boats

Sails for Oppies, Bug, Toppers, Picos (main) and Funboat are kept rolled on their masts on the left in the right hand container.
 Sails for Lightnings, Lasers, Supernova and Wayfarers are kept rolled (generally on tubes) on the right-hand side of container.
 Pico jibs and Laser 2 sails are kept folded on the right-hand side of container.
 Foils (rudder/daggerboard) for Oppies, Toppers, Picos and Lasers are kept in racks on the left-hand side of the container.
 Laser spars are kept in the boats and should be positioned to hold the centre of the cover up when not in use.
 Booms for Toppers are kept in the boats, and should be positioned to hold the centre of the cover up when not in use.
 Booms for Picos are kept in the boats
