# How You Can Help...

Haversham Sailing Club is run by the members. Everyone is responsible for the upkeep and care of the club. Here are some ways to help look after the club and the facilities:

Put away the club boats and kayaks correctly (even if you didn't get them out!).

If you are camping, take a turn at cleaning up the changing rooms and showers.

Put away the buoyancy aids so everyone can continue to borrow them.

Take glasses back to the bar. If the bar is closed, then wash and dry them in the kitchen and put them on the bar counter.

Wash, dry and put away any used cups, crockery and cutlery. Wipe down the kitchen. Take the tea towels home and wash them.

Volunteer for an extra duty when there is a gap.

Take rubbish down to the bin at the end of the drive. (There are often black sacks left

outside the clubhouse)

Remind others to wear buoyancy aids.

Make sure the bank and water are clear when the racing dinghies are launching or returning. Sweep out the club room. Keep your berth tidy. Be ready to help out whenever you are needed.
