## The Racing Rules of Sailing

The amended Racing Rules of Sailing come into force on the 1st January 2021

Changes include:

- The hull being the part of the boat that counts as being over the line.
- Boats can be marked NSC if they fail to sail the correct course.
- The right of protest is removed where boats/crews are rescued and thought to have gained an advantage.
- Exoneration rules are now all moved to one rule rather than being in three.

Apart from that, changes either don't affect how we race at Haversham or just change wording for clarity.
