



# JUNIOR SAILORS' CODE OF CONDUCT

## Dos and don'ts for children and young people

### **You should always:**

- be supportive, kind and friendly to others
- listen and follow instructions
- be helpful, fair and honest
- have good manners
- treat everyone respectfully
- take responsibility for your own actions
- follow this code of behaviour and other rules, including the law
- co-operate, play by the rules and have fun!

### **You should never:**

- make a nuisance of yourself
- be violent or disruptive
- make fun of other people, pick on anybody or bully them
- be abusive towards anyone, or call them names
- swear, or use foul or suggestive language
- deliberately harm anybody, or damage property
- treat anyone disrespectfully
- spread rumours, tell lies, cheat or steal.

If you act in a way that doesn't follow this code, you will be reminded of it and asked to change your behaviour. If you continue not to follow the code, or if your behaviour is more serious, your parent or guardian will be told and you may be removed from site.
